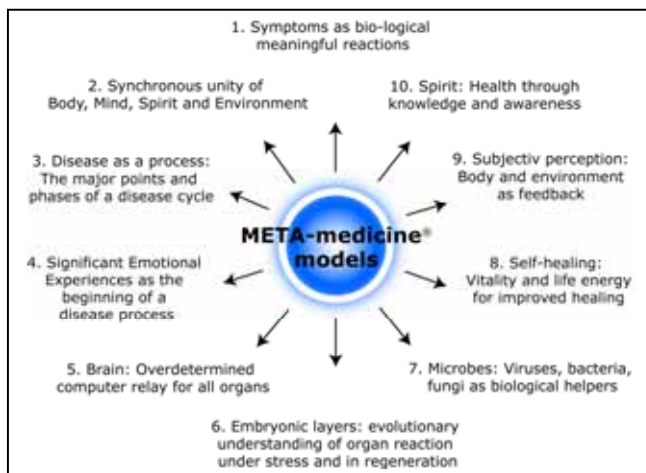


Biological conflicts and disease ...

According to META-medicine®, there is not only a mind body connection but actually a very precise **organ-mind-brain-social connection**. Each area of our brain corresponds to a specific organ and a specific conflict or trauma and an environmental-social experience.

Researchers also found that biological conflict shocks (significant emotional experiences) always precede disease. If we experience such a biological conflict shock (an event that is unexpected, very dramatic and emotional) then our organism reacts with what we call "disease" and symptoms like cancer, eczema, diabetes, etc.

This knowledge is revolutionary, because it allows us to understand how a disease process begins and why therapies often do not work. But this is just the beginning. META-medicine® goes even further. Every organ is directly related to a specific biological conflict content. For example the skin (epidermis, upper skin) is affected by a loss-of-contact-conflict, the breast (ducts) by a separation-conflict, the lungs (alveoli) by a fear-of-death conflict. This means our organism and specifically the organ-mind connection is way more "hardwired and bio-logical organised" than we have thought in the past.

Why is this so important? Well, just imagine how much more precise and quick a holistic diagnosis will be, if we know the exact organ-mind-brain-social connection. Additionally all therapies can be applied way more efficient and more successfully, because we understand the cause, process and meaning of symptoms and therefore support the healing process instead of working against it.

Organ	Biological conflict
Bladder mucosa	Territory-marking-conflict, i.e. can not define boundaries or a position.
Bones	Inferiority-conflict; i.e. we feel not worthy or good enough about something; our boss criticizes us in front of others.
Breast - ducts	Separation-fear-conflict, i.e. from mate, child, mother, home or nest.
Breast - glands	Worry-argument conflict, i.e. with mate, child, mother, home, nest.
Bronchial mucosa	Territory-fear-conflict, i.e. somebody is threatening to invade or leave our territory
Colon	Indigestible-anger-conflict, i.e. anger about our boss, partner, etc.
Eye - cornea	Visual-separation-conflict, i.e. we lost sight of somebody or something.
Eye - retina	Fear-of-attack-conflict, i.e. fear of something we cannot deal with that is threatening or lurking from behind.
Kidney - collecting tubule	Abandonment-isolation-conflict, i.e. fear of being alone, having lost everything or not being adequately supported
Kidneys parenchyma	Water-fluidity-conflict, i.e. almost drowned; suffered a flooding
Lungs - alveoli	Fear-of-death-conflict, i.e. fear of own or somebody else's death; like accidents, cancer diagnosis, etc.
Skin - epidermis	Loss-of-contact-conflict, i.e. the loss of physical contact or the loss of the contact to the mother, the flock, the family, or friends.
